At age 9, Joe started playing with his father's band; performing traditional Swiss music in various clubs and private engagements throughout the Western states. His love for his musical heritage nurtured his interest in Swiss Folklore (Ländler) music and he began composing in this style at an early age.

Joe's musical interest ultimately resulted in a Master's Degree in music. Joe currently teaches and has to date put 12 of his Swiss compositions on tape for your listening enjoyment. All the instruments are played by Joe, and the songs contain the lively, happy characteristics of Swiss Folklore music.

Flight To Switzerland features 9 new compositions, written and performed by Joe Blaser. During our flight, we will be making a short stop in New Orleans to catch a glimpse of New Orleans Dixieland Jazz in the composition "The Emil Strut." This foxtrot is dedicated to Emil Spahr. We will also stop in Hungary where a fictitious audience in a large concert hall waits for the orchestra to begin. The Hungarian piece, Csardas by V. Monti, features an accordion solo with orchestral background. When our flight arrives in Switzerland, familiar sounds of Swiss Folklore Ländler music will be heard throughout our travels.
